Although highly musical, TaKeTiNa is a deeply relaxing and meditative process that requires no musical experience.

Participants are guided into a state of rhythmic simultaneity, using their voices, hands and feet, in a safe and playful setting.

TaKeTiNa is a process, capable of activating your human and musical potential through rhythm.
